Due to previous technical glitches, the application deadline has been extended. Please note the following changes in the proposed dates and application information.

Deadline Extended up to **4th June, 2019** to be **shortlisted**.

Interview date on **8th June 2019** for shortlisted candidates from **Mumbai** and **10th June** for shortlisted candidates from **out - station**.

The deadline for the video to be sent by only shortlisted candidates is **6th June, 2019** (Mumbai and Out - station both.) Shortlisted applicants will be informed by email on their registered email id.

Applicants will be informed via email if they have been Accepted, waitlisted or not accepted on the course via email. Please check the college website for Merit- List as well.

**1st Merit List: 12th June, 2019.** (Full Payment deadline for the list: **20th June, 2019**).

**If any seats remain unfilled, 2nd Merit List: 22nd June, 2019.** (Full Payment deadline for this list: 30th June, 2019.)

**VERY IMPORTANT: To be shortlisted for the interviews, please fill the form by the above given date (4th June 2019).**

In case of unfilled seats, the application portal will remain open until 22nd June.

**Anyone filling the form after 4th June, 2019 does so at the risk of not being shortlisted and not being accepted on the course this year.**

### **Course Information**

The main objective of the course is to open up this highly specialized discipline of study to the Indian Post Graduate level and to develop competent practitioners in the field of Expressive Arts Therapy.

The focus of the course would be to equip participants with combination of theoretical foundation and hands on skills. Thus enabling graduates to incorporate these skills in socially challenging environments within educational and developmental settings and supplement their existent capacities.

The 5 papers per semester will focus on :

- 1) Expressive Arts Therapy Theory (Art, Drama, Movement , Music and Inter-modality)
- 2) Expressive Arts Therapy Skills (Art, Drama, Movement , Music and Inter-modality)
- 3) Counseling Theories, Processes and Skills
- 4) Fieldwork
- 5) Research Design and Methodology

Credits: 48 credits (810 hours)

Curriculum includes: Teaching contact hours, fieldwork, supervision and research paper.

Faculty: Internationally Certified Faculty from across the country.

Duration: 1 year (Part-time)

Days: Thursday, Friday & Saturday.

Timings: First semester - 2pm to 8pm

Timings in this semester will vary based on fieldwork (Thursday, Friday, Saturday).

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1) Graduation in any subject (Provisional admission for those awaiting graduation results).
- 2) No age restriction for admission.
- 3) The application will be scored based on academics, statement of purpose, relevant personal and professional experience.
- 4) Shortlisted candidates will be called for experiential and theoretical interview. Interviews will be held at St. Xavier's College, Mumbai in person or online for out-station and international applications.
- 5) Shortlisted candidates will have to create an audition video of 5 minutes to support their expressive arts therapy application using any one or more of the following modalities (art, drama, poetry, music, movement and photography) : to be submitted on 6th June, 2019.
