RULES UNDER AUTONOMY

As per Ordinance of University of Mumbai 0.6086 dated 05/05/2014, 75% attendance at Lecturers / Practical's per Course is mandatory. Students joining this College are required to read and accept the provisions of the rules under Autonomy in the College Handbook.

- The College expects 100% attendance at all lectures / practical's per chosen Course. As there are legitimate reasons why 100% attendance is not possible, a minimum of 75% attendance per course is made mandatory (Refer: Ordinance of University of Mumbai 0.6086 dated 05/05/14).
- A student with less than 75% attendance in a Course (including tutorials) will not be allowed to appear for the ESE in that Course.
- A condonation of up to 50% of lectures / practical's per Course could be made at the discretion of the Principal within the ambit of Mumbai University Ordinance no. 0.6086 dated 05/05/2014., in the following cases:
- Serious illness authenticated by a Doctor's Certificate and Medical Records & submitted within 2 working days of resuming classes.

UNDERTAKING

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1. I hereby agree to abide by the College Rules regarding attendance, viz., that if my attendance is found to be unsatisfactory, I shall not be permitted to give the Semester Examinations.
2. I fully understand that my admission to St. Xavier's College (Autonomous), Mumbai is for the subject combination given for the FYBSc/BA.
