2	<p>Learning Objectives: Understanding the ethical factors entailed in scientific and technological innovation.</p> <p>Becoming aware of diverse biomedical options and their consequences affecting human and animal life.</p> <p>Recognizing and evaluating these issues, for applying in life.</p>
3	<p>Learning Outcomes: The contact hours of the course will introduce participants to several ethical theories and practical applications, which will be comparatively presented and evaluated. It will benefit those who may wish to focus on either comparative or applied ethics—and to thus do only the respective module which appeals to their interest (“Comparative and Normative Ethics” or “Applied Ethics”). Finally, the course will also provide “elective” options for those who wish to focus on one or other aspect of the eight modules of the course. This may be especially useful for Xavier’s students who wish to gain Honours’ course credits.</p>
