Becoming aware of the intricacies and nuances of belief and practice within different Indigenous traditions.</li> <li>3. Understanding how different traditions have developed over time.</li> <li>4. Appreciating the need for better inter-religious relations as a social resource in facilitating civic peace and harmony.</li> </ol>

While religion promises to be a rich resource for civic peace and harmony, it has not always been so.
