Details of the Activity	
1	Title: Understanding the basics of Indian Classical Music and Dance
2	Learning Objectives: The course is divided into two sessions. The first session is designed to give students a basic idea and history about sitar as an instrument and the basics of 'raag' through a lecture demonstration. In the second session, the students will be about to learn about the different Indian classical dance forms through lecture demonstration followed by a workshop.

3	<p>Learning Outcomes: At the end of both the sessions the students will acquire:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A basic understandings of <i>raag</i>. 2. They will have better idea about sitar as an important instrument used in Indian classical music. 3. They will be able to comprehend better about different forms of classical dance and their cultural relevance.
4	<p>Description: The course comprises two independent sessions, each spanning 3 hours. The students will be exposed to lecture-demonstration as well as workshop. At the end of both the sessions the students will have to submit two written assignments one on each session (time allotted: 9 hours). The assignments will be assessed by the resource persons. Grades will be given based on the assignments as well as their attendance.</p>
